

4th Hour Safety/Privacy/Security

-Slide 1: *Discuss with students what they think or know about "Safety, Privacy, and Security on the Internet"*

-Discuss how most instances of predatory behavior online aren't the stereotypical situations like the first video

Things not to share...

-Full name

-Address/where you live

-Phone # or e-mail

-Birthday

-Any personally identifying information

-Photos of your drivers license Drivers License

What to do if something online or in a text makes you uncomfortable...

-TELL A TRUSTED ADULT RIGHT AWAY

-Stop communication immediately

-Do not give out requested information

Discuss with class why they may want to make social media profiles private, think long term, finding jobs, things that others might post without their control

This shows where to set twitter so that tweets are blocked to strangers and those who you haven't approved

Slide 6

Facebook has very complicated privacy settings, at the very minimum make sure that your profile is set to friends only

Slide 7

Facebook has an option so that you can see what your profile looks like to any specific person or group of people

Password tips

-Slide 8: In the fall of 2013 Adobe software had their database hacked and leaked with personal information. These are the top 10 passwords with the number of users who used each one. out of around 13 million users. Adobe makes software such as photoshop and video editing programs all used here at PW.

Have students prepare a quality password. Make a blank document and cold call students to show examples (But tell them not to use real passwords of their own!)

Slide 11:

Don't share your school account and password information with anyone! This could result in cheating penalties here at school along with losing access to your own account temporarily or permanently according to the terms of use agreement and school handbook.

The Rights of Others

Slide 12:

Discuss why students think permission should or should not be asked to take a person's photo

Let them that unauthorized photo taking or use of students or staff will be considered harassment here at school with potential consequence of suspensions.
