

High School: Art I & Art II

The Art I students have just completed the creation of the orb shape called an Icosahedron. These are a 20 sided shape that will display a series of drawings of abstract imagery. They are looking through some images of Zentangles and adapting those ideas to their work.

After the construction of those sculptures were completed they were challenged to create a bowl or vessel of some kind. They are working on choosing their own materials for the creation process. Some students have taken on the challenge of creating their work out of air-drying clay, others have chosen magazine pages, and others have used a mixture of materials.

Each creation has its own back story and displays a variety of information on the surface.

Art II students are working on a variety of projects and a variety of materials. They are working on creating fiber art work through weaving, string art, and even needle felting. They are also continually working on their own body of artwork for their sketchbook designs. There is also a group that are working on a Smash Book Art journal that

is a series of challenges they must work through to create different designs. Many of the Art II students are seniors and are working on completing their work before they graduate. They are planning on making a few more pieces before the end of their school year!
