Portland St. Patrick's to Host a Michigan State Police Canine Unit Training Tuesday, June 11 from 8 a.m- 5 p.m.: The Michigan State Police have selected our facility as a training location for their Canine Units on Tuesday, June 11th from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. in the Annex Building (old C.I.A./daycare). Please be aware that there will be numerous MSP vehicles, troopers, dogs, and equipment parked adjacent to the building along Center and West Street as they conduct training. West Street alongside the school will still be accessible for drop-off and pickup. The local authorities will be communicated through the MSP prior to the start of training.

Please keep the west side of West St. and the south side of Center St. clear next Tuesday from any parking so that the MSP can adequately stage their equipment and personnel.

<u>Summer Building Construction</u>: Please note that if you come on the St. Patrick Parish/School campus this summer, there may be construction going on due to the installation of the new roof as well as work be completed from the Michigan State Police Safety and Security Grant. Some entrances may not be available at any given time or day.

The parking lot between the church and school will be closed starting June 13th as we begin the roofing project. All visitors and staff, including basketball and volleyball camp attendees, must use the door (#6) on West Street closest to Grand River to enter the school. Do not park on the school side of any streets.

Attention Grandparents: Sports passes for grandparents will not expire starting this fall. Make sure you pick up your orange colored grandparent pass this fall to attend all future St. Patrick School sporting events.

Plan ahead and schedule a physical now. The form will be good for all sports throughout the 2018-19 school year.

2019-20 Dress Code Changes: Since styles have changed, and there have been questions about several items, the St. Patrick School Board reviewed dress code issues/concerns that have been coming into question in recent years and have implemented the following changes for the 2019-20 school year:

- Sweater vests or long sleeve sweaters, V-neck or crewneck cardigans or pull-overs must be hunter green, navy or white, with no zippers and must be hip length only.
- Long sleeve shirts may not be worn under short sleeve shirts. Long sleeve polo shirts are still allowed.
- Approved warm up jackets ordered this school year during the online sale with a school uniform shirt worn underneath are allowed. These will be available to order in the fall.
- Fleece jackets and vests are no longer allowed.
- Socks must be matching solid hunter green, navy blue, black or white.
- Dri-fit material polos are recommended due to their ability to maintain color longer.
- Recommended Vendors: Kohl's, Educational Outfitters and JCPenney.
