- The St Pats bus has been scrapped. Athletic transportation will be handled by a combination of leveraging the Portland High buses and using parent transport where appropriate
- Football, Volleyball, and Cross-Country coaches and teams are preparing for fall sports
- Jr High football will not have games, but will have organized practices for ~4 weeks
