Shamrock Fall Fest update by Jill Scheurer. They are looking for new heads for all departments in the next few years. Raffle chair is open now. Income for fall fest is \$31,098.54. All went well with the revisions of vendors as the gym was out of commission.

Gym floor update: Floor is complete except for the shamrock to be painted on the center of the court which is tentatively set for thanksgiving break. Final costs are not in but the funding for the project will come from the Athletic Association general fund. A safe estimate on the total cost is 80K.

Father Flohe Building update: The weight room is in place. Ideas were shared on heating of the building. A high-level estimate was given for studs, insulation in wall and ceiling, and lines ran for heating source from Plants and Grounds to the AA. After paying for the gym, AA looking at budget and where money can come from and how much they can do at this time. The AA does not look to be in a financial position to support the entire completion of the building project. Alternatives are being evaluated.
