

## Announcements for St. Patrick School for March 20, 2020

1. **Important Lesson Pick Up/Drop Off Information:** We will no longer have packets picked up inside the building, rather they will be outside the doors for pickup as outlined below. **Therefore, please note the important information for picking up and dropping off homework packets/lessons and returning any completed work. Please make sure that work being returned is in a folder with the students name on it. (Please note that if the weather does not allow for lessons to be placed outside, they will be right inside the doors at the assigned locations.) \*Papers/folders have been sitting for three days before pick up and will sit again for three days after drop off.**

**Pick up time for Monday, March 23, 2020 will be from 9:00 a.m. - 12 p.m. and from 5:00 - 7:00 p.m.**

Door #1 (the main office door): Grades 3-5 - pick up and drop off

Door #7 (the center set of doors on West St.):

- Grades 6-8 - pick up and drop off (many lessons will still be downloaded on Google Classroom)
- Grades 9-12 - drop off only (lessons will continue to be supplied online through Google Classroom)

Door #8 (On the corner of Center St. and West St.): Grades PS-2 - pick up and drop off.

2. **Spring Break for St. Patrick School:** Spring Break for St. Patrick School will remain as scheduled, April 4th - 13th. There will not be any assignments to complete during this time. The last pickup/drop off of elementary lessons before spring break will be Monday, March 30. If we are still not in session after spring break, the next scheduled pickup/drop off of lessons will be Tuesday, April 14. Teachers in grades 6-12 will not have any lessons added to Google Classroom from April 6 through April 13. Please continue to pray that school will resume on April 14 as scheduled.
3. **Ordering through Office Depot:** Anyone in the diocese can go to this web link (the Grand Rapids Diocese Cost Management Portal <https://grdiocese.thesisportal.com>) and be able to register for an Office Depot account under the Grand Rapids Diocese discount pricing on over 300,000 items. The prices displayed to and paid by the user will be the same price that

would be available to GR Diocese parishes and schools. Payment by the user is with their credit card only, with shipments to the user's home. There is no cost to join this program. Availability is shown for items put into the shopping cart so that toilet paper, disinfecting wipes, and other short-supply items, etc. can be ordered when they are available and sent directly to the home address of the user.
