<u>Thank You</u>: We want to thank our school families for being faithful during such a challenging time. Thank you for supporting our parish, our school, your children, each other, and for staying connected. Thank you for continuing to live our mission. We are humbled and very appreciative for all of you and we continue to keep you in our thoughts and prayers.

Important Grading Clarification: It is important for our school community to know and understand that per a diocesan directive, students must complete every assignment. They will not receive a zero on an assignment that is not completed or handed in. Instead, it will be entered in Infinite Campus as "missing" until it is completed or until Friday, June 5. After that date, the assignment will change to an incomplete. It will remain incomplete until it is completed and turned in or it will remain throughout the summer until August 7. Once August 7, comes, the assignment will become a zero and a final grade will be issued. Therefore, it is imperative that all students complete every assignment by June 5 or they will have to complete work throughout the summer.

The same is true for seniors but their final date is Friday, May 15. We will not be able to give seniors who have incomplete assignments their diploma or send transcripts on to colleges until they have a grade for each one of their assignments.

Monitor Grades on Infinite Campus: Regarding the grading clarification noted above, it is extremely important that parents continue to monitor if their children are turning in assignments and to see how they are doing academically.

<u>Drop-Off/Pick-Up Date</u>: Reminder – our next and final pick-up date for grades PS-8 is Monday, May 11. We will again utilize the same system we have used on past drop-off/pick-up dates. High school students may drop-off anything that needs to be returned as well on this date.

Door #1 (the main office door): Grades 3-5 - pick-up/drop-off Door #7 (the center set of doors on West St.):

- Grades 6-8 pick-up/drop-off (many lessons will still be downloaded on Google Classroom)
- Grades 9-12 drop-off only (lessons will continue to be supplied online through Google Classroom)

Door #8 (on the corner of Center and West Streets): Grades PS-2 - pick-up/drop-off

Beginning Tuesday, May 26, there will be a box for each teacher

for students in grades K-5, one for middle school and one for high school outside the **main office doors** for parents or students to turn in completed work.

There is currently a box labelled "office" that is outside the main office entrance daily from 8:30 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.

Faith and Future Scholarships: Faith and Future Scholarships have been applied to tuition accounts for those who have registered and applied for the scholarship. The chance at one year free tuition and the scholarship expires on May 22. These scholarships are available for students going into grades kindergarten, 6th, and 9th. Please go to this <u>link</u> to apply if you have not already done so.

2020-2021 Enrollments: Thank you to everyone who has returned your continuous enrollment documents for the 2020 – 21 school year. Please turn in enrollments by mailing them to St. Patrick School or by dropping them in the "office box". We will be calling families that we have not heard from beginning on May 12.

Please note that if you are no longer enrolling your child(ren) at St. Patrick School for the next school year, your family will need to complete an exit survey for your student(s) to be unenrolled. Exit surveys can be obtained by contacting the school office. If you fail to notify the school about unenrolling a child by June 1, your SMART Tuition account will be billed for the upcoming school year.

<u>Graduation</u>: The graduation ceremony for the Class of 2020 has been changed to Sunday, June 14. We have also scheduled Sunday, July 12 as a backup date.

Registration for LCC begins May 18th! If your student is planning to participate in dual enrollment through LCC next year, please make sure they have the following steps completed:

- Apply to LCC
- 2. Activate LCC account using a link sent to student's email.
- Complete dual enrollment approval forms and send them to Mrs. Garcia. These can be found at the following link: https:// www.lcc.edu/community/documents/dual-enrollment-approvalform.pdf
- Placement: Upload SAT/ACT scores and send them to lccdualenrollment@lcc.edu or lcc-testing-services@lcc.edu No SAT/ACT scores? Complete Placement Testing through LCC.
- 5. Request Transcripts to be sent to LCC through Parchment.com.
- 6. Let Mrs. Garcia know when these steps have been completed.
