2020-21 Sports Physicals: Per MHSAA: Sports Physical Examinations for the 2020-21 school year will be waived for students in any grade who received a valid physical for sports during the 2019-20 school year (one completed on or after April 15, 2019). These students and their parents/guardians will still be required to complete the two-page MHSAA ANNUAL SPORTS HEALTH QUESTIONNAIRE (found on MHSAA.com). These must be signed by students and parents/guardians and kept on file in the school before participating in any sport.

Students who did not receive a sports physical in the 2019-20 school year after April 15, 2019, must have a valid physical examination form on file. If a student is discovered to have participated without a valid physical or Health Questionnaire on file, the student shall not be eligible to participate until a valid physical is on file.


