Program Effectiveness Surveys: It is time to complete the annual diocesan satisfaction survey. Please take the time to complete this survey at your earliest convenience. It will only take about 10-15 minutes to complete. The survey must be completed by Thursday, April 15. We truly value and appreciate your feedback. This year the survey will be for grades 5-8 and grades 9-12. Families that return the last page of the survey by April 16 will receive out of dress code slips.

Enrollment for the 2021-2022 school year: A letter was emailed to all parents to officially open the enrollment for next fall. We are using continuous enrollment which means that you do not need to do anything to register your child(ren) for the 2021-2022 school year if returning in grades K-12. The \$50 per student registration fee and \$75 per family technology fee will be added to your first SMART Tuition payment. New students in preschool, kindergarten and older grades will need to fill out the paperwork which can be found on the website. Please see the letter for more information.

Students not returning for the 2021-2022 school year: Families will need to complete an exit survey to be unenrolled for the 2021-2022 school year. Exit surveys can be obtained by contacting the school office. If you fail to notify the school about unenrolling a child by June 1, 2021, your SMART Tuition account will be billed for the upcoming school year.


