Congratulations: To our St. Patrick students who were confirmed this past week.

Last day of school: Fr. Mike has announced the last day of school as Thursday, June 3rd. He will be meeting with faculty and staff on Friday, June 4th to hold Mass and holy hour as well as celebrate all of their hard work with gratitude. Grades 6-11 will dismiss at 10:50a and grades K-5 will dismiss at 11:30a. There will be no busing at dismissal. No childcare will be available.

Out of dress code days: June 1, 2, and 3 will be out of dress code days for all students.

<u>Medication in the office</u>: If your child has medication in the office, please pick it up the by the last day of school. Any medication left in the office on June 11th will be disposed. If your student requires medication during school hours, please remember that new forms need to be on file in the office each year. This includes self possessed medication. Plan ahead to have your physician sign the paperwork during the summer.

**Sports Physical Forms**: In order to participate in practices and play games on a St. Patrick School team, a sports physical must be on file in the school office for all athletes in grades 5-12. The forms can be found on the school website under the About Us tab (in Documents/Forms), on the Michigan High School Athletic Association website, or in the school office. Plan ahead and schedule a physical now. The form will be good for all sports throughout the 2021-22 school year when dated after April 14.

Students not returning for the 2021-2022 school year: Families will need to complete an exit survey to be unenrolled for the 2021-2022 school year. Exit surveys can be obtained by contacting the school office. If you fail to notify the school about unenrolling a child by June 1, 2021, your SMART Tuition account will be billed for the upcoming school year.
