SPS Middle School Football: St. Patrick School is proud to announce that we will be offering a middle school football program for the fall of 2021. We will be part of the Central Michigan 8-Man Football Conference. The first practice will be Monday, August 23rd. Our MS Football Head Coach is Mr. Joe Cook. Your child will need a physical to begin practices. We encourage all of our middle school students who are interested in playing football to participate in our program. Registration forms were passed out to 5-7 grade students and are available from Mr. Russman.

Sports Physical Forms: In order to participate in practices and play games on a St. Patrick School team, a sports physical must be on file in the school office for all athletes in grades 5-12. The forms can be found on the school website under the About Us tab (in Documents/Forms), on the Michigan High School Athletic Association website, or in the school office. Plan ahead and schedule a physical now. The form will be good for all sports throughout the 2021-22 school year when dated after April 14.

Students not returning for the 2021-2022 school year: Families will need to complete an exit survey to be unenrolled for the 2021-2022 school year. Exit surveys can be obtained by contacting the school office. If you fail to notify the school about unenrolling a child by June 1, 2021, your SMART Tuition account will be billed for the upcoming school year.
