

SPLASH PAD INFORMATION

The splash pad is open from Memorial Day to Labor Day, 7 days a week, from 9:00 A.M. to 9:00 P.M. The water spray operates on a timer that is activated with the simple touch



of a large button on the 3-foot-high bollard located at the west side of the splash pad.

Rules:

- Do not drink the water.
- Children 10 & under must be accompanied by an adult.
- Swim diapers required for infants and toddlers.
- Pets are not allowed.
- No running or reckless behavior.
- No bicycles, scooters, skateboards, rollerblades, or similar recreational equipment.
- · No pool toys, floats, or chairs.
- No bathing soap, shampoo, or detergents
- Splash pad may be closed at any time due to weather, maintenance, or other operational concerns.
- Splash pad must be vacated at the first sign of thunder or lightening.
