Clay targets \$4/rd Paid to the Oakhill Gun Club (Punch card 10rds/\$40) (2 competition rounds/wk + 2 practice rounds/wk x 8 weeks = \$128 for the season)

Shells Needed - 32 total rounds for season (practice + competition) = 32 boxes of shells price \$7-12/box retail



## What is it?
