<u>2023-24 Financial Aid Applications</u>: The <u>application</u> and <u>instructions</u> were emailed to all families. The deadline for round one is December 4, 2022. This applies for students in grades K-12. A new application must be filled out each year. This information can also be found on the school website under Prospective Families, Tuition/Scholarships. Please contact the office for assistance. The sooner you apply, the better!

<u>Last day for shorts</u>: The last day that students can wear uniform shorts to school is Monday, October 31st.

SchoolAdmin Tuition Management System: Thank you families for being patient with us as we implement the new SchoolAdmin Tuition Management System. You may have noticed that late fees have been turned off while we all acclimate to this new system. Starting with the November tuition due date, the late fees will be turned on. Please note that if your payment is not received by your due date a \$35.00 late fee will be applied to your bill.

<u>Vision Screening</u>: The Ionia County Health Department will be here on Tuesday & Wednesday, November 1 & 2 to screen students in grades PS, 1, 3, 5, 7 and 9. If you have a child that you would like to be screened, please let the office know.

<u>Hearing Screening</u>: The Ionia County Health Department will be here on Tuesday & Wednesday, November 1 & 2 to screen students in PS, K, 2nd, and 4th grades. If you have a child that you would like to be screened, please let the office know.

<u>Hall Walking</u>: Hall walking is open to the public starting November 1 through March 31 from 6:00-8:00pm on days that St. Patrick School is in session (full days of school only). You may enter the building using door #7 on West Street. Hall walking is NOT available on Mondays when childrens faith formation classes are in session.



### St. Patrick MEGA ROCK Raffle



St. Patrick Parish and School continue to seek out new ways to meet the financial needs of our parish, school, and athletic programs. One of the new ways of trying to fund these programs is through a new raffle that will begin after Labor Day, this is the St. Patrick MEGA ROCK Raffle.

The oldest student of each Shamrock family brought home the MEGA ROCK raffle tickets. We are asking all school families to sell four tickets each. Tickets may also be purchased using our <u>One Cause</u> account. Please note that when a family refers an individual to purchase a ticket online, those sales will count towards that family's sales total.

It is important to note, this new raffle will replace the weekly sports raffle, the Fall Festival raffle, the Parish Festival raffle, and the large Shamrock Auction raffle. Instead, we will have one annual raffle where the tickets will be sold for \$500 each. This provides our benefactors the opportunity to win more cash prizes while not being asked to purchase tickets four times a year. The goal is to sell 1,000 tickets which will help fund our parish, school, and athletic programs.

There will be 4 drawings with MEGA prizes that will take place throughout the year. Drawings will take place at the:

- Fall Festival on October 15
- Marriage Gala on February 11
- Shamrock Auction on April 21
- Parish Festival on June 24

There will cash prizes totaling \$11,250 at each of these events. The breakdown of cash prizes at each drawing are as follows:

Grand Prize: \$5,000
2nd Prize: \$2,500
3rd Prize: \$1,000
4th Prize: \$750
5th Prize: \$500 (2)
6th Prize: \$250 (4)

There will also be a monthly drawing on the last Friday of each month for 10 months with one \$500 winner per month beginning Friday, September 30.

#### One does not need to be present at any of the drawings to win.

Raffle sales will begin immediately after Labor Day with the special opportunity to "buy two tickets and get one free ticket" from September 6 through October 9. Winning tickets will be put back into the drawing each time, so it is possible to win multiple times. It is important that all our stakeholders support this raffle as it will go a long way in supporting our parish, school, and athletic budgets.

Any family that sells four tickets (either a printed copy or online) will receive an Out of Dress Code slip for each student in the family. The families who sell the most tickets will received the following additional prizes:

- 1st Place: 10 Out of Dress code slips and a \$100 scrip gift certificate of their choice.
- 2nd Place: 7 Out of Dress Code slips and a \$75 scrip gift certificate of their choice.
- 3rd Place: 5 Out of Dress Code slips and a \$50 scrip gift certificate of their choice.
- 4th Place: 3 Out of Dress Code slips and a \$25 scrip gift certificate of their choice.
