## Dear Parents,

St. Patrick Catholic School has officially opened enrollment for *new* families in the 2023-2024 school year. We are using continuous enrollment which has two components: I) signing a registration contract and terms of service your first year, and 2) annual enrollment into tuition management, which is online with SchoolAdmin every year thereafter. Once you have submitted enrollment paperwork and it has been processed, you will receive an email from us with a link to complete your enrollment in SchoolAdmin and tuition management; please follow the instructions and complete this at your earliest convenience.

Please note that the billing due date for ALL accounts will be reset to the 20th once this school year is over. If you need a due date that is different from the 20th, please contact the school office.

If you are anticipating receiving financial aid, please sign your tuition agreement in SchoolAdmin before May I. Financial aid award letters are expected to be sent out in May. Your account will be adjusted accordingly once the information becomes available.

The \$50 per pupil non-refundable registration fee, \$100 technology fee, and \$38 SchoolAdmin payment plan fee (for anyone not paying in full) will be due at the time you enroll. The registration fee helps defer the administrative cost related to the continuous enrollment of each student in addition to the cost of Infinite Campus, our student management system. Each year, staff has to update each student's information in various systems for tuition, classes, etc. The technology fee of \$100 per family assists with technology-related expenses, such as IT services and our 1:1 Chromebook program for all students in grades KG-12.

We want to make sure you are aware that the *total* cost to educate a student at St. Patrick School is NOT the billed tuition amount. The *total* cost to educate students in grades KG-8 is \$5,910 and a student in grades 9-12 is \$8,170 for the 2023-24 school year. The table below shows the amount that will be charged per student (again, you are **not** charged the *total* cost). We are appreciative of St. Patrick Parish, who provides the school with support from the offertory, the School Board Finance Subcommittee, the Parish Finance Council, our Advancement and Development team, the Father Flohe Foundation, the Former Pastor Shamrock Endowment Fund, and the Diocese of Grand Rapids for their annual support of our parish school. Through the collaborative efforts of these groups, our parish and school administration are working hard to ensure our school is run efficiently and our programs are

adequately funded. St. Patrick School will continue to do all that we can to keep tuition costs stable.

We are mindful of the immense financial sacrifices required to provide your child(ren) with a faith-based education and we are grateful for your commitment to St. Patrick School. This year's tuition rates allow us to maintain and improve the quality of all our course offerings and programs. It also allows us to give our school staff a salary increase as a token of our appreciation for their dedication to your children.

The 2023-2024 tuition rates for students attending St. Patrick School are as follows:

The before and after school childcare program is available for students in grades KG-5. Please inquire with the office for rates.

The daycare operates in conjunction with the preschool for 3 and 4 year old children. Enrollment preference is given to students enrolled in SPS preschool. Please inquire with the office or daycare for rates.

- Any children in the same family (grades KG-12), enrolled at the same time, past the 4th child will attend St. Patrick School at no charge except the \$50 per pupil non-refundable enrollment fee.
- Each preschool student will be charged the same per-child rate.
