Flu Season is Here: Please be diligent with simple prevention strategies such as frequent handwashing, sneeze/cough etiquette, and staying home when sick. Many illnesses do not require exclusion. However, children should stay home if the illness prevents the child from participating comfortably in school activities or if there is risk of spreading sickness to others. Some reasons why a child should stay home include fever, diarrhea, vomiting, and abdominal pain. Children should not return to school until they are fever, diarrhea and vomit free for 24 hours without medication.

Liturgical Seasons of the Catholic Church

We as Catholics are given the extraordinary opportunity to live differently than the rest of this world in more ways than one. First and foremost, we are called to live differently in the way we act, the way we prioritize our lives, and the way we treat others. Secondly, we are able to live on a different calendar so to speak! This is called the "liturgical calendar" in which our liturgical seasons are outlined. Fun fact: The Church's liturgical calendar begins with Advent!


Each season has a primary color associated with it and is often displayed on the vestments that the priests and deacons wear during that time frame.

Purple is used during Advent and Lent and symbolizes penance preparation.

White or Gold is used during the Christmas and Easter seasons as well as feast days of the Blessed Mother and angels and saints who aren't martyred. It symbolized joy and purity.

Green is used during ordinary time and is a symbol of hope, life, and growth.

Red is used on Passion Sunday, The Triduum, and Pentecost as well as on the feast days of the apostles and martyrs. It symbolizes sacrifice.
