WINTER SPORTS REGISTRATION:

Registration for winter sports will open on October 1st. Available programs:

- 1ST/2ND GRADE BASKETBALL: Season begins in early January and runs through the middle of February. Teams will practice one night a week and play games on Saturday mornings. Practice days and times will not be established until the December coaches' meeting.
 - Deadline: Monday, December 2, 2024
 - Cost: \$55 Res/\$65 NR
- DK/KINDERGARTEN: Leagues will take place in March. There are two available options: Mondays and Wednesdays OR Tuesdays and Thursdays. Teams will practice and scrimmage each hour-long session.
 - Deadline: Monday, February 3, 2025
 - Cost: \$45 Res/\$55 NR
