Dress Code Policy Update: The St. Patrick School Board has approved the following update to our dress code policy. Leggings are now permitted under skirts/jumpers. Please see the details below.

ADDITIONAL ITEMS: Socks may be worn with any attire. Leggings, tights and nylons are permitted only under skirts or jumpers. Please refer to the chart below for acceptable colors and styles.

ITEM	ACCEPTABLE COLORS & STYLES
Socks	Solid black, navy, hunter green or white, no patterns or logos; must be matching
Tights	Solid black, navy, hunter green or white, no patterns or logos, non-textured
Leggings	Solid black, navy, hunter green or white, no patterns or logos, non-textured; must wear socks with leggings
Nylons	Natural, skin tone, navy, off white/white or hunter green, non-textured
Jeggings	Not permitted
Yoga Pants	Not permitted
