ADDITIONAL ITEMS: Socks may be worn with any attire. **Leggings, tights and nylons are permitted only under skirts or jumpers.** Please refer to the chart below for acceptable colors and styles.

ITEM	ACCEPTABLE COLORS & STYLES
Socks	Solid black, navy, hunter green or white, no patterns or logos; must be matching
Tights	Solid black, navy, hunter green or white, no patterns or logos, non-textured
Leggings	Solid black, navy, hunter green or white, no patterns or logos, non-textured; must wear socks with leggings
Nylons	Natural, skin tone, navy, off white/white or hunter green, non-textured
Jeggings	Not permitted
Yoga Pants	Not permitted
