We are excited to have you join our Shamrock family!

For more than 115 years, our dedicated teachers and staff have helped children grow spiritually and academically. We look forward to partnering with you to reinforce the Catholic values taught at home and to help your child become the person God has called them to be.

Tuition rates for the 2025-26 school year are:

• Any children in the same family (grades DK-12), enrolled at the same time, past the 4th child will attend St. Patrick School at no charge except the non-refundable \$50/student registration fee.

• The multi-child discount is not available for preschool.

Our goal is to keep tuition as low as possible while providing a quality Catholic education that prepares students for life beyond the classroom. To assist us in this regard, we collect the following fees:

Non-Refundable Registration Fee	\$50/student	
Technology Fee	\$100/family	
Finalsite Payment Plan Fee	\$38/family *if not paying tuition in full	

The registration fee helps defer the administrative cost related to the enrollment of each student in addition to the cost of our student management software. The technology fee helps offset costs associated with our IT services and our 1:1 Chromebook program.

Before and after school childcare is available for students in grades DK-5. The fee for each session (before and after) is \$7.50/day/student.

We are mindful of the immense financial sacrifices required to provide your child(ren) with a faith-based education and we are grateful for your decision to choose St. Patrick School. Financial aid is available from the Diocese of Grand Rapids and St. Patrick Parish. To apply for financial aid, please visit: <u>Blackbaud Financial Aid Application</u> or <u>SPS Tuition/Scholarships Webpage</u>. This application is required for financial assistance consideration. If you are awarded financial aid, your account will be adjusted accordingly once the information is available (expected in June).
