



Dear returning family,

We are excited that your child will once again be joining us for the 2025-26 school year! All students are currently scheduled to automatically re-enroll and you only need to complete a few simple steps to finish the process:

1. Login to Finals site and complete the steps for **each of your children by May 1**. Links can be found at the bottom of this letter. ***NEW THIS YEAR: If returning students are NOT enrolled (all three steps completed for each child) or the Intent to Withdraw is not completed by May 1, your account will be rolled over as is (same payment plan); if you want to change your payment plan, it MUST be done before May 1. Your student will not receive their Chromebook or be eligible to participate in extracurricular activities until you have completed the Enrollment Acknowledgements and Agreements. The registration/technology/payment plan fees will be charged when we roll over accounts on May 6, 2025.***
2. If you are adding a new student in your existing school family, login to your portal and "add a student" on the student tab.
3. Review your account information. If there are any updates or errors, please contact luankinsman@portlandstpats.org.

We are grateful for the financial support offered from St. Patrick Parish, our Advancement and Development Team, the endowments available to us from the Father Flohe Foundation and The Former Pastors' Shamrock Endowment Fund, alongside the Diocese of Grand Rapids. This support allows us to keep our tuition below the actual full cost to educate your child, which is more than \$6,000 for students in grades DK-8 and more than \$8,400 for high school students.

We continue to work with the Parish Finance Council and the School Board Finance Subcommittee to make sure tuition remains as low as possible while also allowing us to improve the quality of our course offerings and extracurricular programs in addition to providing a salary increase to our incredible and dedicated staff. We are working hard to pay our staff at least 80% of the salary of their public school counterparts. Thank you for your understanding and commitment to St. Patrick School!

- Any children in the same family (grades DK-12), enrolled at the same time, past the 4th child will attend St. Patrick School at no charge except the non-refundable \$50/student registration fee.

- The multi-child discount is not available for preschool.

Our goal is to keep tuition as low as possible while providing a quality Catholic education that prepares students for life beyond the classroom. To assist us in this regard, we collect the following fees:

Non-Refundable Registration Fee	\$50/student
Technology Fee	\$100/family
Finalsite Payment Plan Fee	\$38/family *if not paying tuition in full

The registration fee helps defer the administrative cost related to the enrollment of each student in addition to the cost of our student management software. The technology fee helps offset costs associated with our IT services and our 1:1 Chromebook program.

Before and after school childcare is available for students in grades DK-5. The fee for each session (before and after) is \$7.50/day/student.

We are mindful of the immense financial sacrifices required to provide your child(ren) with a faith-based education and we are grateful for your decision to choose St. Patrick School. Financial aid is available from the Diocese of Grand Rapids and St. Patrick Parish. If you are awarded financial aid, your account will be adjusted accordingly once the information is available (expected in June).

IMPORTANT: For dual household families that are prompted to invite a second signer, **both parties MUST have their own unique Parent Portal Account to sign the contract.** You will not be able to proceed in the process if you use the same email address to log into the Parent Portal.
