Please also note the following:

- All high school students are expected to have an exam during their scheduled exam time. The only exceptions would be students taking a dual enrollment college course or a Michigan Virtual H.S. course (assuming they have completed the course-work for that class). If a student does not have an exam scheduled, they should not be in the school during that time.
- Students in grades 9-11 will be allowed to leave the building as soon as their second exam of the day is complete EXCEPT on Thursday. On Thursday, all students who have a first hour exam are REQUIRED to stay for Mass.
