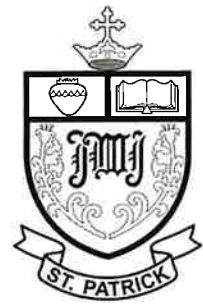

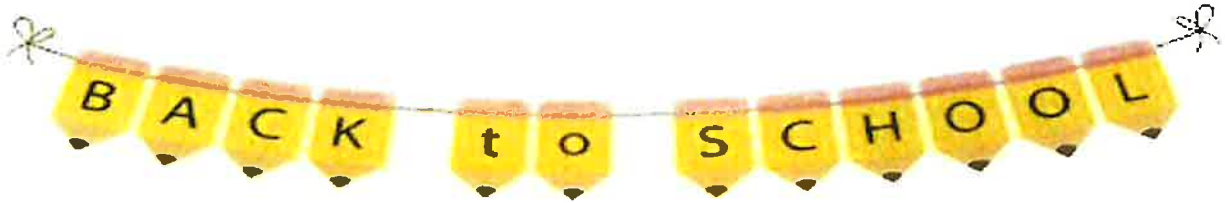

If your child is entering a licensed childcare, kindergarten, 7th Grade or a new school district they must have immunizations up-to-date or a vaccine waiver on file.

To waive vaccines for school or childcare you **must** make an appointment with your Local Health Department to obtain an official waiver form.
