Virtue Corner

Virtue of the Week: Prayerfulness

Prayerfulness falls under the Cardinal Virtue of Justice. Justice enables one to give to each, beginning with God, what is due to him.

Definition:

The habit of being in the presence of God, taking time to be with Him, talk with Him, and seek communion with Him (like a friend).

Opposing Trait:

- Entertaining distractions during prayer and Mass.

Ways to Cultivate:

- Maintain the proper posture (kneeling, sitting still, etc)
- I spend time with God daily in prayer.
- I talk to God throughout my day.
- I entrust my needs and those of others to God in prayer.
- I thank God for His blessings.
- I ask God what His will for me is in matters great and small.

Family Discussion Challenge:

Pray a decade of the Rosary together as a family meditating on the mystery you choose to draw your heart into the life of Christ.


