Parent/Teacher Conference Request Forms: Conferences will take place on February 13. The request forms are being sent home for elementary and middle school students and were emailed to high school parents. Please return them ASAP if you need to schedule a conference. These conferences are optional unless one is specifically requested by your child's teacher. If your child's teacher does not request a conference but you would like one, please feel free to request a conference. Spring conferences are by appointment only.

Remote Learning Days: We currently have reached six snow days. The Diocese of Grand Rapids allows six snow days before we are required to switch to remote/virtual learning. In the event we have another snow day, **packets were sent home for grades DK-5, check Google Classroom for grades 6-8, and check Canvas for grades 9-12 for coursework.** Attendance will be counted by collecting your child's completed assignments. Please see the email/packet for more information.

Dress for the Weather: As a reminder, DK-5 students are outside for recess unless the weather prohibits, as outlined below:

- b. Wind chill 0-9°F: students will have recess in the parking lot
- c. Wind chill below 0°F: students will remain indoors

We had several students not dressed appropriately this week. Remember that the temperature changes throughout the day. Please bring winter coats, snow pants, gloves, hats, and snow boots to school every day.
